WHAT WE OFFER TO STUDENTS AND FAMILIES

Our program is based on a multi-disciplinary model that offers a variety of services on a daily basis. In addition to academic programs that include academic assistance and supervised study time, we also deliver family counseling, individual and group skill-building and structured recreation.

Emotional and behavioral diagnoses are addressed and assessed continually by our residential counselors, teachers and therapists, all of whom are highly skilled and capable of on-site care at all times. Our therapeutic and academic environments are characterized by appropriate supervision, safety, and positive reinforcement. Our holistic approach includes attention to physical health and vocational training, which constitutes an effective intervention to stabilize students and promote their development.

The specific services delivered to an individual student is determined by an **Individualized Service Plan**; which utilizes a team approach involving the student, family members, academic staff, case manager, residential counselors, service providers and mentors. This process consists of an assessment of the educational needs of the student, identification of desired outcomes

relative to the assessed needs, and a determination of specific services directed toward achieving identified goals. Planning is ongoing as needs are continuously re-assessed and targeted goals and services are adjusted during Service Plan reviews every 30 days. Beginning with the point of admission and throughout the entire program, efforts are made to ensuring successful transitions for students back into their families.

At Judon Academy, students are welcomed without regard to race, religion, or economic background, and each student is provided with full access to all of the services we offer. If special challenges arise, our vast network of outside services is available for referrals.
